Lid Dixon is an American singer-songwriter known for writing lyrics that explore poetic structures in interesting ways (and for an obsession with hats). He has been compared to Elliot Smith, Lou Reed, Paul Westerberg, Jeff Tweedy, and John Prine.

Dixon grew up at 9,000 feet in the Rocky Mountains of Colorado in a log cabin that didn't get TV or radio. By the time Dixon was 20 years old he had a lot of catching up to do – not knowing anything about Bob Dylan, Neil Young, The Rolling Stones, Bob Marley, etc. The cabin was filled with sounds of Waylon & Willie, Sons of the Pioneers, and Merle Haggard, which had a noticible influence on his songwriting.

After a solid 8-years of studying drugs¹, Dixon landed in Washington DC, and started writing, performing, and recording music. -- off and on in Austin, TX, Philadelphia, PA, and Boulder, CO. Then, things took off when he relocated to Fort Collins, Colorado. Dixon says, "Fort Collins has such a great music scene. Innspired me to write and record two studio records in a couple years. It's been a wonderful experience."

"Rodeo Clown" is Dixon's second EP in the last 12-months. Parlor Trick was released in 2023. Dixon comments, "Rodeo Clown is very different sonically than. Since Parlor Trick was released, I've been playing more band shows and that's how we approached the songs."

Dixon says, "I realized that I don't need a million dollars – with \$635,271 and 32 cents, I could just play music and not worry. I only need 6.3 billion streams and I'm there. Luckily, I recently released an EP, Rodeo Clown, with 4 original songs and a cover of Lou Reed's Walk on the Wild Side. I already have the 32 cents, by the way."
